Thank you for raising this concern. Let me quickly clarify the situation to clear the doubt about the security.

1. **About the country:** As of now, only 2 regions (Northwest and Southwest) are concerned with security issues. The 8 other remaining regions have no security concerns.
2. **About Yaoundé:** Yaoundé which is in the Centre Region and is the Capital of Cameroon is very far from the regions concerned and highly secured. Lebohang can testify. The town is quiet safe, calm and friendly. But as we always advice, our guests need to limit night hours to avoid any unforeseen inconveniences.
3. **About the venue:** Mont Febe is the second most important in the Country. It is at 1km from the Presidency and very safe. The hotel has its own security guards mixed with the public security forces operating without uniforms.

To conclude: There is no security concern as far as Yaoundé is concerned. Two days before the beginning of the conference, there will be major sub-regional trade-fare in Yaoundé as well which could have been postponed or cancelled if there were security risks since many business people come from abroad. So all participants should fill free and should have no stress to come to Yaoundé.

CBCHS has analyzed this aspect carefully and can testify that it will be safe to host the Conference in Yaounde.
